PAN AM 707 Speed record from HNL to SFO

by Ross Burmaster (1966- 1986)

I was a 707 FEO based in SFO in the 60's. Since, I have moved many times since then and also lost many items, including some of my memory, I don't remember the names of the crewmembers or number of the aircraft, only the incident!

Those of you that flew out of SFO during that time, will remember that it was a four and half (4 ½) to five and half (5 ½) hour flight time from HNL to SFO on a 707. I don't remember all the facts about this flight, except it was a RED EYE from HNL to SFO. When I came down from my room at the layover hotel in HNL that night to check out, I noted my Captain was very turned on about something. He was talking to a number of "Lounge Lizards" in the lounge of the hotel and seemed very excited about some thing.

When I came over to greet him, he looked up and said, "Hey, Ross, I think we may have a chance to break the record!" I answered: "What record?" He then said: "The flight time record from here to SFO!"

He then pointed out that United Airlines in a DC-8 held the flight time record from HNL to SFO in a commercial jet and it was three hours and 28 minutes! Quite fast, when you figure how long it usually took us.

He said that he had been talking with a number of the Pan Am crews flying in from the West Coast to HNL that day and they ALL said they had very high head winds. So, he figured if we had those same winds going home, they would be tail winds and maybe we could break the speed record.

Thus, as we were going through our Take Off checklist, he briefed us (The crew), he wanted to make a HIGH speed climb, cruise @ .85 Mach and make a high-speed descent into SFO! A couple of reasons, that helped us ~ continued on next page

during that time frame was: NO, 250 Speed limit under ten thousand feet and not much traffic in those days in the early morning hours in the SFO Bay area. SO, NO radar vectoring around the South Bay area!

ALL went as planned and we were able to fly direct to SFO airport from the inbound Oceanic check point, so the Captain flew right over the airport, chopped the power, popped up the speed brakes, did a 90 – 270 degree turn over the bay and we landed on RUNWAY 19 Right! It turned out we did it in three hours and fourteen minutes (3+14) from Takeoff to landing! Broke the old record by fourteen (14) minutes!!!

As were taxiing in to the terminal, the Captain told the PAXs about our record-breaking flight, and of course, there was lots of clapping and "HOORAYS"!

That was the good news. The BAD news, was since we had arrived, almost TWO hours early, there was NO Ramp Crew or anyone around to park us! The evening crews had gone home, and the morning crews had NOT arrived at the airport yet!

In those days, the terminal was still dark! Pan Am Ops was finally able to get a few mechanics that were working the graveyard shift at the Engine Overhaul department to come over to the terminal and hook us up to a power unit, so we could shut down the engines. They were also able to bring up one of those stairway trucks to put a stairway up to the aircraft, so we could disembark from the airplane.

NO, PAX ramps to the airplane from the terminal in those days!

We, the crew were able to get our bags and walk across the ramp to the hanger/parking lot and go home. Not sure how long the PAXs had to wait for their bags, but I'm sure they were NOT happy after that!!!

Later that day, I decided to go to the Local News stand/store in San Mateo, you may remember there was a news shop next to the theater on 2nd Ave, in San Mateo at that time?

As it turned out, there was a headline in the local San Francisco afternoon edition of the newspaper about PAN AM, but not our flight! It turned out, the Pan Am flight from Tokyo to SFO that night had a woman doctor from Thailand on board, and she had delivered her own BABY! A girl.

THE REST OF THE STORY:

The Captain had put the article in a local paper down the Peninsula where he lived, I think maybe Los Gatos, but I'm NOT sure now. I came in to report for a trip a week or so later, and there was a newspaper clipping in my crew mailbox with the write up about our "record breaking flight"!

About four or five months later, I was operating a Pan Am flight from SFO to Tokyo and after my meal, had decided to walk to the back of the airplane and see how everything was going in the cabin.

When I got back to the last row of ECY, I noted a Stewardess sitting in the seats A thru C and she did NOT look happy. I also noted she seem to have a bassinet in the seats next to her. I asked her," Is that yours?" She, naturally, answered, NO!

AS, it turned out, the parents were working in Ohio and were sending their baby daughter to the grandmother in Bangkok, Thailand.

So, this brand NEW Stewardess, being on Reserve in JFK, was assigned to accompany the baby to Bangkok!

She told me she didn't know what was wrong with the baby, but she just cried! I said, well, I have a couple at home like that, and usually the first thing you check is their diaper to see if it needs changing!

Thus, I helped her to change the baby, had the galley stewardess heat the milk bottle in the Hot Cup and showed the young lady how to feed the baby and so forth.

I found the Purser and suggested that the other members of the cabin staff help the Stewardess out and watch out for her, and also suggested she brief the ongoing crew from Tokyo to Bangkok to help out also!

When I got back to the cockpit, I told the Captain about the incident and said:" You know, instead of Pan Am crew scheduling in JFK scheduling a Reserve Stewardess to accompany the baby girl to Bangkok, you'd think, they would ask any of the mothers that worked in Scheduling or Admin, Just to see if any one would like to go (with baby experience) and just pay the Reserve Stewardess for the trip or at least put it on the open time board!!!

To those who understand the world of flying.

You see them at airport terminals around the world. You see them in the morning early, sometimes at night.

They come neatly uniformed and hatted, sleeves striped; wings over their left pocket; they show up looking fresh.

They know the up-and-down walk to the gates at Dallas, the Texas sparseness of Abilene, the very narrow Berlin Corridor, New Orleans' sparkling terminal, the milling crowds at Washington. They know Butte, Boston, and Beirut. They appreciate Miami's perfect weather; they recognize the danger of an ice-slick runway at JFK.

They understand short runways, antiquated fire equipment, inadequate approach lighting, but there is one thing they will never comprehend: Complacency. They marvel at the exquisite good taste of hot coffee in Anchorage and a cold beer in Guam.

They vaguely remember the workhorse efficiency of the DC-3s, the reliability of the DC-4s and DC-6s, the trouble with the DC-7 and the propellers on Boeing 377s. They discuss the beauty of an old gal named Connie. They recognize the high shrill whine of a Viscount, the rumbling thrust of a DC-8 or 707 on a clearway takeoff from Haneda, and a Convair. The remoteness of the 747 cockpit. The roominess of the DC-10 and the snug fit of a 737. They speak a language unknown to Webster.

They discuss ALPA, EPRs, fans, mach and bogie swivels. And, strangely, such things as bugs, thumpers, crickets, and CATs, but they are inclined to change the subject when the uninitiated approaches.

They have tasted the characteristic loneliness of the sky, and occasionally the adrenaline of danger. They respect the unseen thing called turbulence; they know what it means to fight for self-control, to discipline one's senses.

They buy life insurance, but make no concession to the possibility of complete disaster, for they have uncommon faith in themselves and what they are doing.

They concede the glamour is gone from flying. They deny a pilot is through at sixty. They know tomorrow, or the following night, something will come along they have never met before; they know flying requires perseverance and vigilance. They know they must practice, lest they retrograde.

They realize why some wit once quipped: "Flying is year after year of monotony punctuated by seconds of stark terror." As a group, they defy mortality tables, yet approach semi-annual physical examinations with trepidation. They are individualistic, yet bonded together. They are family people. They are reputedly overpaid, yet entrusted with equipment worth millions. And entrusted with lives, countless lives.

At times they are reverent: they have watched the Pacific sky turn purple at dusk and the stark beauty of sunrise over Iceland at the end of a polar crossing. They know the twinkling, jeweled beauty of Los Angeles at night; they have seen snow on the Rockies.

They remember the vast unending mat of green Amazon jungle, the twisting Silver road that is the father of waters, an ice cream cone called Fujiyama; the hump of Africa. Who can forget Everest from 100 miles away, or the ice fog in Fairbanks in January?

They have watched a satellite streak across a starry sky, seen the clear, deep blue of the stratosphere, felt the incalculable force of the heavens. They have marveled at sun-streaked evenings, dappled earth, velvet night, spun silver clouds, sculptured cumulus: God's weather. They have viewed the Northern Lights, a wilderness of sky, a pilot's halo, a bomber's moon, horizontal rain, contrails and St Elmo's Fire.

Only an aviator experiences all these. It is their world. And once was mine Forever missed.
